

RPAC Supported Primary Election Candidates

On March 13, 2008, the Trustees of the PAR REALTORS® Political Action Committee (RPAC) met to discuss support of candidates for the upcoming primary election.

In cases where the incumbent legislator is retiring or is not running for re-election, a candidate interview must be conducted by a local association/board before the RPAC Trustees may provide support to a candidate.

In instances where a candidate interview was conducted, and a recommendation was forwarded from the local association/board, the RPAC Trustees voted to support the following candidates in Open Seat races:

Many local associations/boards decided not to pursue interviews in advance of the primary election, but will conduct interviews prior to the general election. An updated list of supported candidates will be available in the fall.

The RPAC Trustees also discussed support of all incumbent legislators who are running for re-election. In no instance did the Trustees vote to support a challenger against an incumbent.
