## PREF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### **Background Information:**

PREF annually presents scholarships to deserving REALTORS® to help them continue their education and professional development. Scholarships can be used for tuition to any REALTOR® designation or SREC-approved broker course and reimbursement of lodging & travel expenses (upon submission of hotel bill or receipts) up to a maximum scholarship amount of \$500.

The following courses will be eligible for scholarship reimbursement: ABR, ABRM, ALC, CCIM, CIPS, CPM, CRB, CRS, CRE, GAA, Green, GRI, PMN, RAA, SIOR and SRES. The following REALTOR® certification programs are also eligible: At Home with Diversity, e-PRO, RSPS and TRC. In addition, courses approved by the State Real Estate Commission for broker credit are eligible.

A non-profit organization, the Pennsylvania REALTORS® Education Foundation was established in 1969 by the Pennsylvania Association of REALTORS®. The Pennsylvania REALTORS® Education Foundation enhances the professionalism and profitability of real estate licensees in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by funding and supporting industry research and the development of timely, relevant and practical educational tools and projects.

### **Eligibility:**

Applicants must currently be a PA REALTOR® member and have held REALTOR® membership for at least two years. The scholarship applies to courses taken between January 1 and December 31 of the upcoming calendar year. Applicants who have previously received a PREF Scholarship are ineligible for additional PREF Scholarships.



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Applications must be received PREE by July 31<sup>st</sup>. Completed applications should be mailed to: PREE, 500 North 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Lemoyne, PA 17043-1213. No faxes, please. An email will be sent by PREE to confirm receipt.

A complete application must include the following items:

1. Scholarship Application completed and signed by the applicant, and verified by the Association Executive or Staff Specialist.
2. Letter of recommendation from the applicant's broker/manager.

Applications will be evaluated on a 30-point scale according to the following break-down:
