AN ACT

1 Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled
2 "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing
3 powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of
4 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing
5 penalties; and making repeals," further providing for
6 definitions, for application of act, for adoption of
7 regulations, for administration and enforcement, for changes
8 in Uniform Construction Code and for exemptions.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 ~~Section 1. The definitions of "agricultural building" and~~ <—

13 ~~act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the~~

6 ~~more than three stories in height with a separate means of~~
7 ~~egress which includes accessory structures.~~

9 ~~"Utility and miscellaneous use structures." Buildings or~~
10 ~~structures of an accessory character and miscellaneous~~
11 ~~structures not classified by the Building Officials and Code~~
12 ~~Administrators International, Inc., in any specific use group.~~
13 ~~The term includes carports, detached private garages,~~
14 ~~greenhouses and sheds having a building area less than [500]~~
15 ~~1,000 square feet, except in a city of the first class, a county~~
16 ~~of the second class where the building area is established by~~
17 ~~local ordinance and a county of the second class A. The term~~
18 ~~does not include swimming pools or spas.~~

6 ~~known as the Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety~~
7 ~~Standards Authorization Act, which certifies that it conforms to~~

- 1 (1) UTILIZED PRINCIPALLY FOR RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY;
2 (2) NOT UTILIZED AS A DOMICILE OR RESIDENCE FOR ANY
3 INDIVIDUAL FOR ANY TIME PERIOD;
4 (3) NOT UTILIZED FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES;
5 (4) NOT GREATER THAN TWO STORIES IN HEIGHT, EXCLUDING
6 BASEMENT;
7 (5) NOT UTILIZED BY THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON AS A
8 PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT;
9 (6) NOT A MAILING ADDRESS FOR BILLS AND CORRESPONDENCE;
10 AND
11 (7) NOT LISTED AS AN INDIVIDUAL'S PLACE OF RESIDENCE ON
12 A TAX RETURN, DRIVER'S LICENSE, CAR REGISTRATION OR VOTER
13 REGISTRATION.

14 "REPAIR." THE RECONSTRUCTION OR RENEWAL OF ANY PART OF AN
15 EXISTING BUILDING FOR THE PURPOSE OF ITS MAINTENANCE.

16 "RESIDENTIAL BUILDING." DETACHED ONE-FAMILY AND TWO-FAMILY
17 DWELLINGS AND MULTIPLE SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLINGS WHICH ARE NOT
18 MORE THAN THREE STORIES IN HEIGHT WITH A SEPARATE MEANS OF
19 EGRESS WHICH INCLUDES ACCESSORY STRUCTURES.

21 "UTILITY AND MISCELLANEOUS USE STRUCTURES." BUILDINGS OR
22 STRUCTURES OF AN ACCESSORY CHARACTER AND MISCELLANEOUS
23 STRUCTURES NOT CLASSIFIED BY THE BUILDING OFFICIALS AND CODE
24 ADMINISTRATORS INTERNATIONAL, INC., IN ANY SPECIFIC USE GROUP.
25 THE TERM INCLUDES CARPORTS, DETACHED PRIVATE GARAGES,
26 GREENHOUSES AND SHEDS HAVING A BUILDING AREA LESS THAN [500]
27 1,000 SQUARE FEET. THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE SWIMMING POOLS OR
28 SPAS.

26 (7) ANY RECREATIONAL CABIN IF:

27 (I) THE CABIN IS EQUIPPED WITH AT LEAST ONE SMOKE
28 DETECTOR, ONE FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND ONE CARBON MONOXIDE
29 DETECTOR IN BOTH THE KITCHEN AND SLEEPING QUARTERS; AND

13 UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(7), UPON TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE
14 RECREATIONAL CABIN, WRITTEN NOTICE MUST BE PROVIDED IN THE
15 SALES AGREEMENT AND THE DEED THAT THE RECREATIONAL CABIN:

16 (I) IS EXEMPT FROM THIS ACT;

17 (II) MAY NOT BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE UNIFORM
18 CONSTRUCTION CODE; AND

19 (III) IS NOT SUBJECT TO MUNICIPAL REGULATION.

29 (8) THE REGULATIONS SHALL EXCLUDE SECTION R313.1.1 OF
30 THE 2003 INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE FOR ONE- AND TWO-

1 FAMILY DWELLINGS OR ITS SUCCESSOR CODE FROM APPLYING TO
2 EXISTING ONE-FAMILY AND TWO-FAMILY UNIT DWELLINGS UNDERGOING
3 ALTERATIONS, REPAIRS OR ADDITIONS BUT SHALL INCLUDE
